- **Attend evaluations in April (see website for exact dates). Tentative dates: Midgets (April 14th - 16th); Squirts, Peewee, Bantams May 11th-13th); Girls Tier II (April 28th- 29th).**
- **Register for USA HOCKEY online (after May 1st) www.usahockey.com. Fees are NOT included in the dues.**
- **Submit second payment prior to June 1, 2009**
- **Notify treasurer (Diana Simpson) of any specific payment plans prior to June 1, 2009**
- **Print confirmation sheet from USA Hockey**
- **Bring USA Hockey confirmation sheet and additional paperwork (i.e., player/parent agreement) to Second REGISTRATION NIGHT (to be announced).**

QUAKER ICE HOCKEY ASSOCIATION MAWHA GIRLS Tier II PLAYER/PARENT AGREEMENT

This document constitutes a binding Agreement under the laws of the state of Pennsylvania between _____, born on _____, (“The Player”) as well as jointly or severally by the parent or legal guardian, _____, residing at _____, (“The Parent”) and the Quaker Ice Hockey Association (“The Club”), a youth hockey Organization registered with USA Hockey for the 2009/2010 hockey season (“The season”).

1. During the season, the player agrees to play girls amateur ice hockey exclusively for the Quakers Ice Hockey Association with the exception that the player may participate in playing hockey for a school team.
2. The Player agrees that she will attend all ice practices, games, off-ice training, instructional sessions and organized team meetings, except when prevented from doing so for educational obligations or medical reasons, in which case, the player will request permission in advance to be absent, when reasonably possible to do so. The Quakers Ice Hockey Association acknowledges that such permission will be granted for all such reasonable requests. The player agrees that she will maintain her academic and educational course work at the highest-level possible.
3. The Player agrees that she will maintain good citizenship and behavior at all club events, as well as her everyday life, in recognition that her behavior is a reflection upon the Quakers Ice Hockey Association.
4. The Player agrees not to use vulgar or profane language, racial, ethnic or gender related slurs toward teammates, coaches, officials, opponents or spectators.
5. The Player agrees that alcohol, tobacco products and banned substances, which include marijuana, cocaine, and other related drugs, have no place in hockey and they will not participate in their use.
6. The Player agrees that there is no place for violent or overly aggressive play in hockey where the obvious intent is to injure or harm another player.
7. The Parent agrees to respect and show appreciation for the volunteers who give their time to hockey. They further agree not to yell, taunt, threaten or inflict physical violence upon any player, coach, official or spectator at any youth function.
8. The Player and Parent agree to abide by all rules and regulations of USA Hockey, Inc., the Atlantic Amateur Hockey Association, the MAWHA, and the Quakers Ice Hockey Association.
9. The Parent shall be obligated to pay the tuition, set forth by the Quakers Ice Hockey Association, in full by August 1, 2009. The tuition balance shall be paid in three installments March 31st (with registration), June 1st and August 1st. Any other payment arrangements must be approved by the Association’s Treasurer prior to June 1st.
10. The Parent and Player acknowledge and agree that the full tuition must be paid, even should the player decide to voluntarily leave the Quakers Ice Hockey Association, or should the player be discharged from the club for violation of any of the covenants set forth herein.

11. The Quakers Ice Hockey Association does not guarantee nor promise that they can improve the college or professional hockey potential of the player. However, the club will provide, to the best of its ability, the best environment, coaching and skill development, so as to assist the player in realizing her full hockey potential.
12. The Player and Parent acknowledge that ice hockey is a contact sport. The player and the parent agree that neither the Quakers Ice Hockey Association, nor any of its officers, agents, coaches and sponsors shall be liable for any injury or damage resulting directly or indirectly from any participation with the club, whether such participation occurs on or off the ice. The player and parent further agree that they hereby discharge the Quakers Ice Hockey Association, its officers, coaches and sponsors from any and all actions, claims and demands for injury or damage. It is understood that said release and discharge shall bind the heirs, legal representatives, successors and assigns of the parties to this agreement. It is further agreed that the Quakers Ice Hockey Association reserves the right to use any pictures taken during any activity for promotional or instructional purposes without compensation to either player or parent.
13. The Player and Parent acknowledge that during the season, or upon the completion of the season, the player may request a release from the club to participate with another club the following season. The issuance of a release by the Quakers Ice Hockey Association is totally within the discretion of the club. Further, under no circumstances will such a release be issued unless the player and parent are in good standing with the club at such time the release is requested.
14. The Player and Parent acknowledge that failure to abide by the rules set forth in this agreement will be cause for disciplinary action up to and including dismissal from the Quakers Ice Hockey Association. Any such action will be referred to the Quakers Ice Hockey Association's Disciplinary Committee.

Discipline Guidelines are set forth herein:

**Severity of Discipline
Action**

Action

Mild: This applies when it is a first offense, which is less severe in nature (mouthing off, etc). The offending individual has shown true remorse and the actions are out of character. There is little chance of this person becoming a repeat offender.

Reprimand, either verbal or written and may carry up to a 2 game suspension.

Moderate: This is for the offenses that are mild to moderate in severity. Applications of this type of discipline would be for a second offense. It would also apply to individuals who have not accepted responsibility for their actions, show no remorse and the likelihood of being a repeat offender are high.

Minimum 3 game suspension but not to exceed 5 games.

Severe: This is for more serious offenses. An example would be physically threatening or assaulting an individual. Application of this type of discipline would be for individuals who have been confirmed repeat offenders or have not accepted responsibility for their actions, show no remorse, are vindictive and are likely to "re-offend".

Minimum of 5 game suspension and may extend up to 1 year.
